This one-day event will feature dozens of research and demonstration projects on Rodale Institute's 333 acres farm.

In addition to presenting the latest research from the well known Farming Systems Trial®, participants will learn about the latest research in soil building and compost making that Rodale Chief Scientist Dr. Elaine Ingham has recently started.

Research partners from USDA-ARS along with Rodale researchers and field technicians will showcase projects that compare organic tilled and no-till systems in vegetable and agronomic crops, production and utilization of inoculum of AM Fungi systems, and our newly developed carbon measurement and monitoring field lab.

Jeff Moyer, Farm Director at Rodale Institute will introduce participants to the new Livestock Grazing project that is a partnership between the Institute and the local community.

Also featured are the Tree as a Crop project and the new Water Purification Eco Center that uses constructed wetlands to treat wastewater.
